## Jesus Walks on the Water

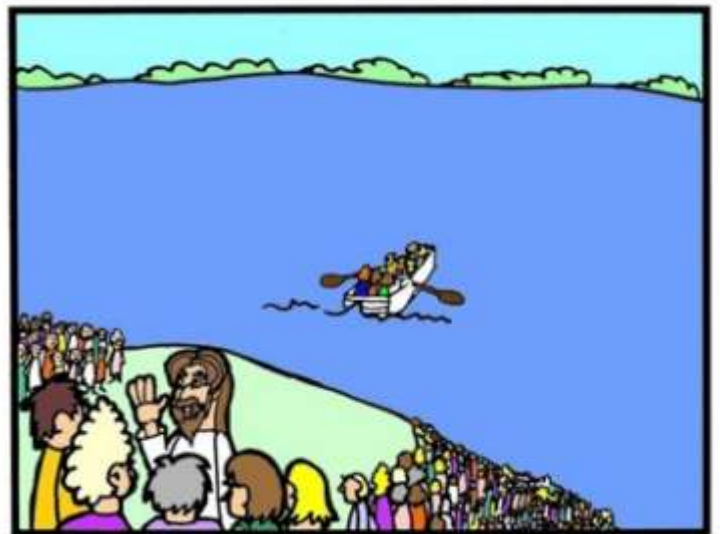
(Based on Matthew 14:22-33, Mark 6:45-51)

At about 4:00 o'clock in the morning while it was still dark, Jesus decided to go and be with his disciples, so he went to them, walking on the sea.

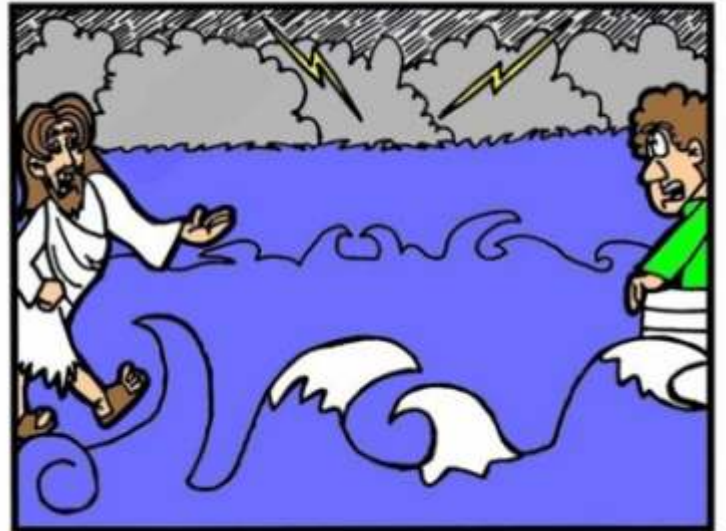
"Ahhh!!!!!!!" screamed the disciples. "It's a ghost!" They were terrified.
