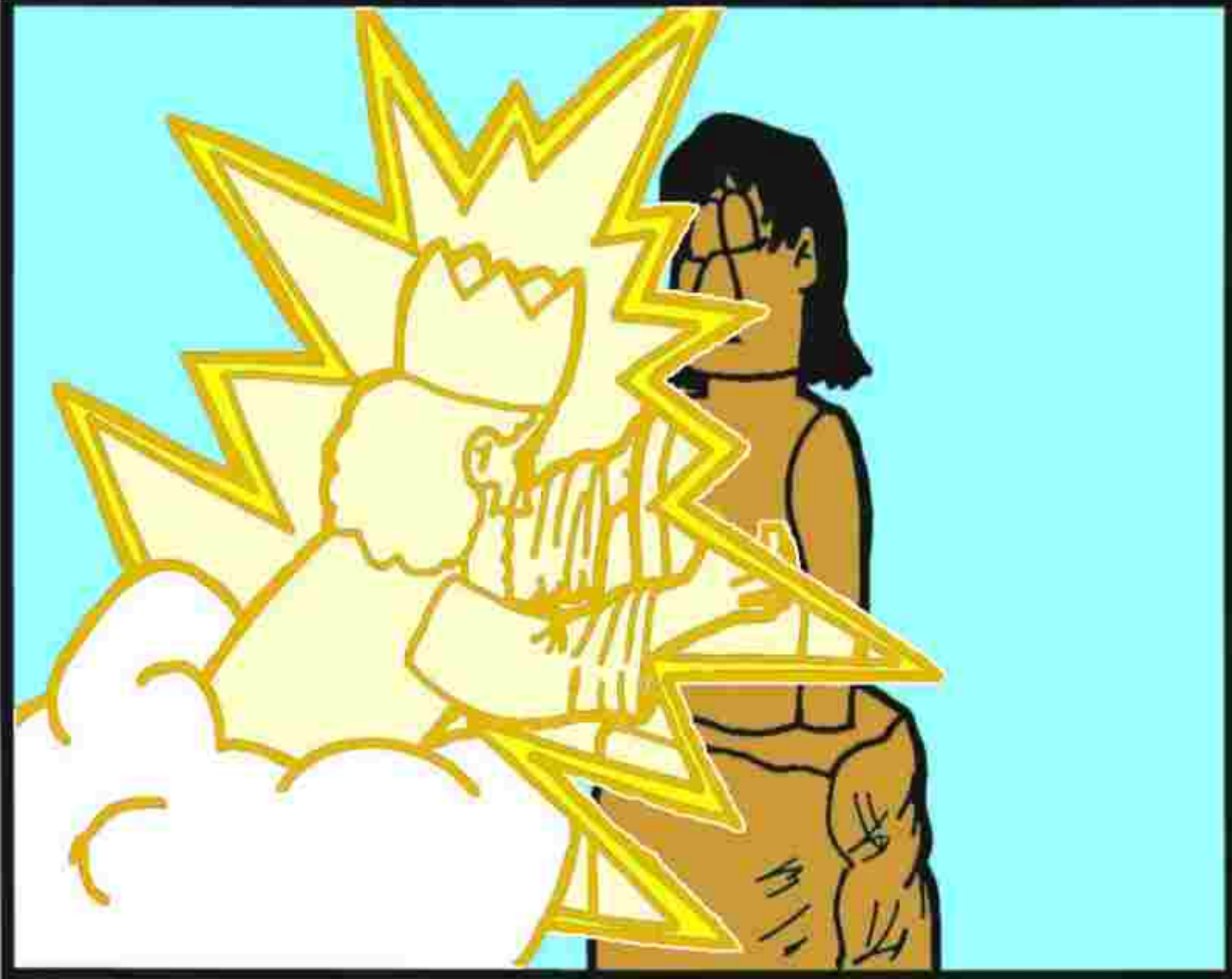


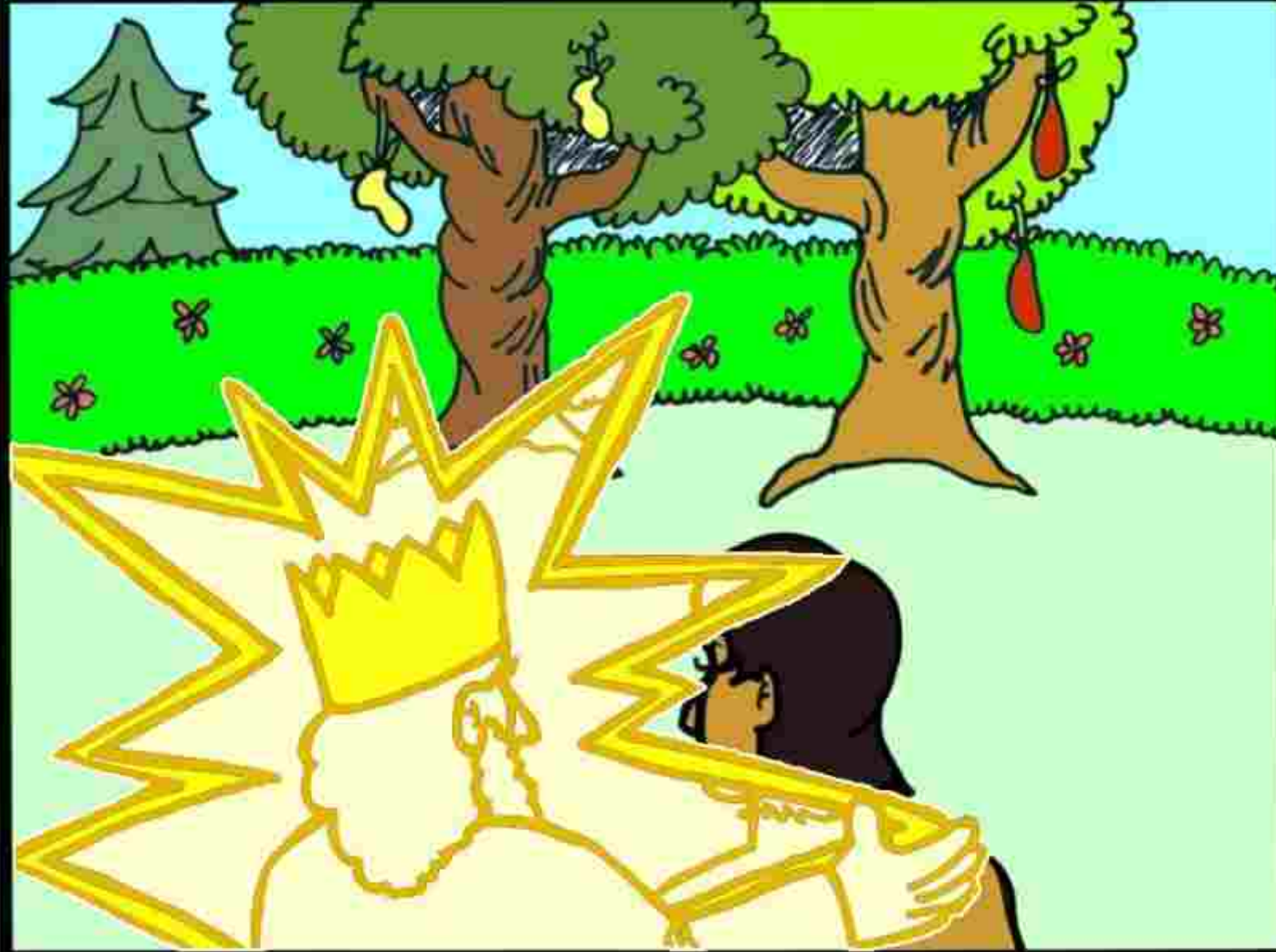
Adam Receives A Wife
