
David acts Insane/David Lives in a Cave



David pretended he was crazy. "Ooh ooh ah ah, screech, screech," chanted David like a monkey as he scratched on the door and drooled like dog.






As soon as the Philistine King and his helpers were gone, David escaped out of their town.




David went to live in a cave and his brothers and their families came to live with him.




Then the people who were stressed-out came to hide with him.



Then the people who were in debt and owed money came to hide out with him.




Lastly the people who just weren't happy with how things were, came to hide out with David. All together there were 400 men and David became the boss over them.
