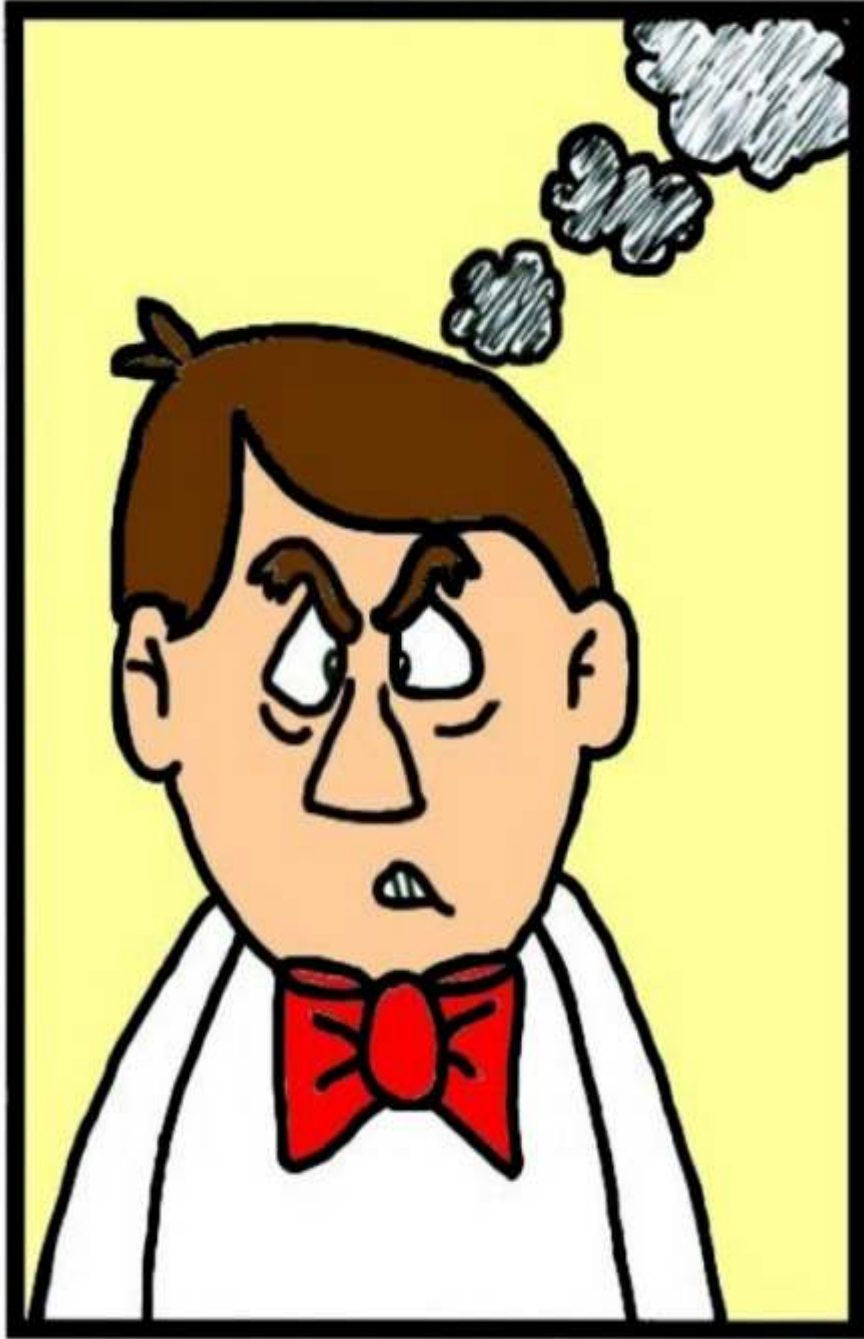
I tell you the master will have the servants sit down, and he will serve them food. Be ready, because I am coming back at a time when people aren't expecting me.
