

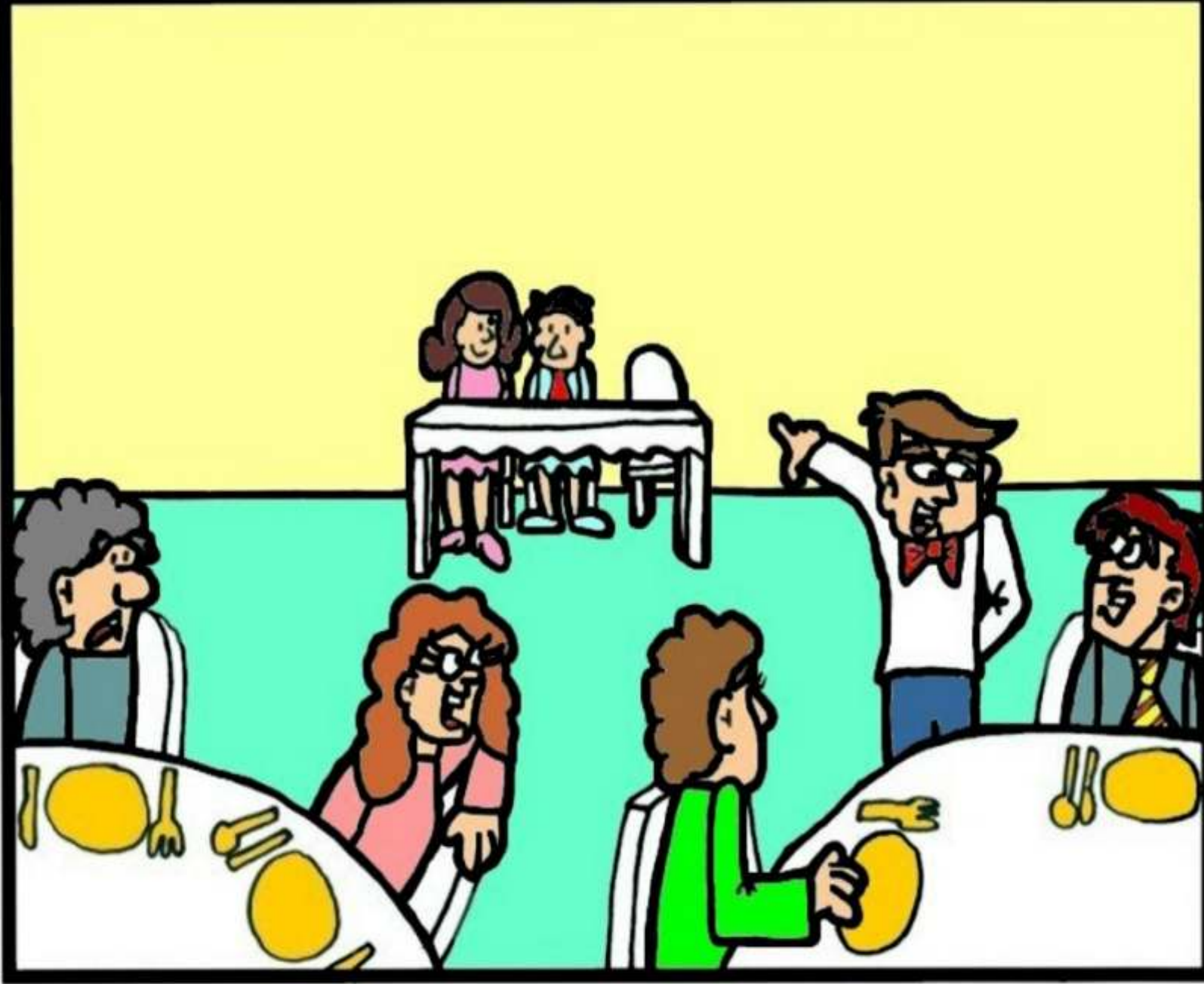
Humility and Feasting

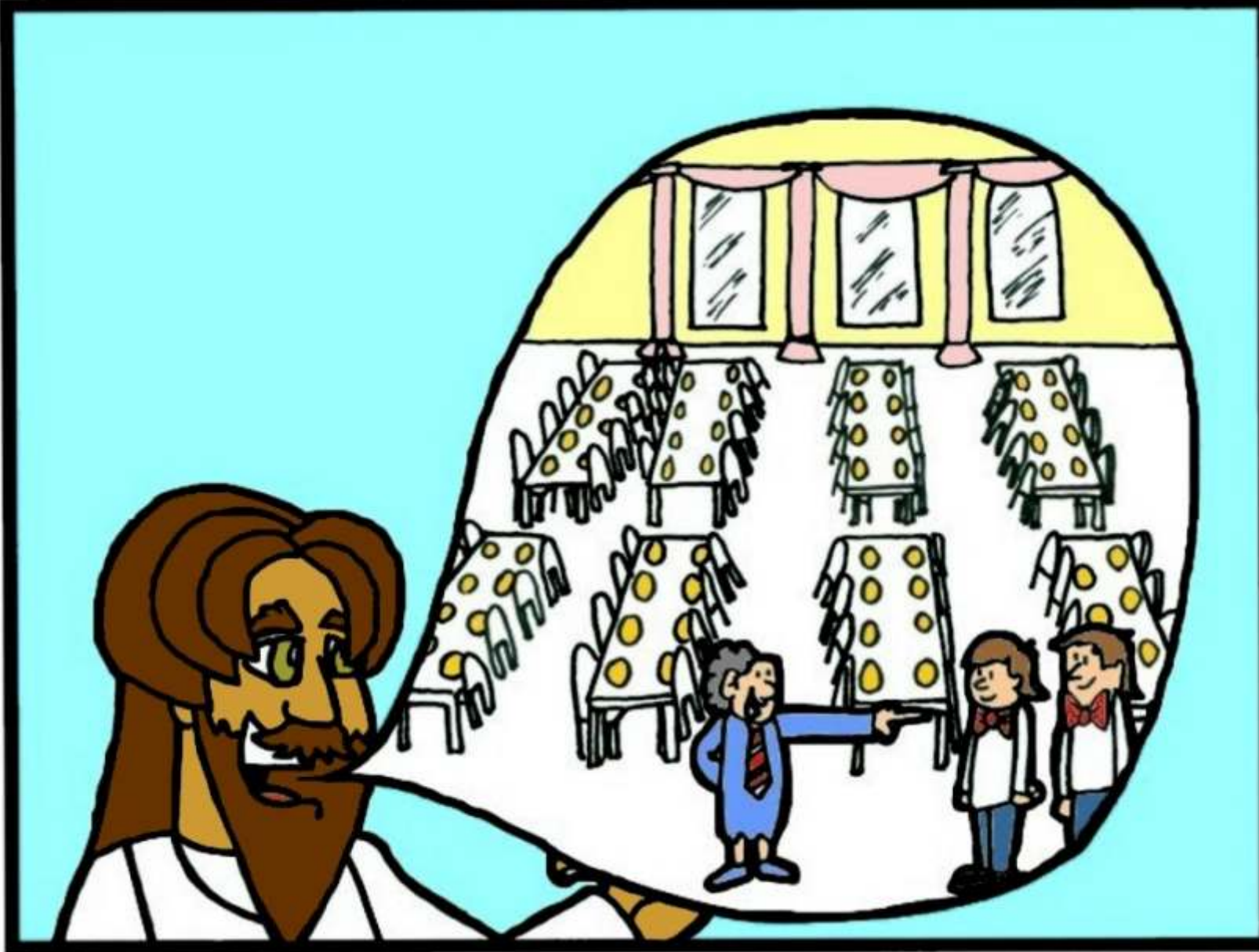
Someone might come and say you are sitting in a very important person's seat and then you will feel very embarrassed when you have to go and sit in a regular seat.

Everyone began to make excuses. The first person said, 'I have bought a field and I have to go and see it. Please let me be excused.'



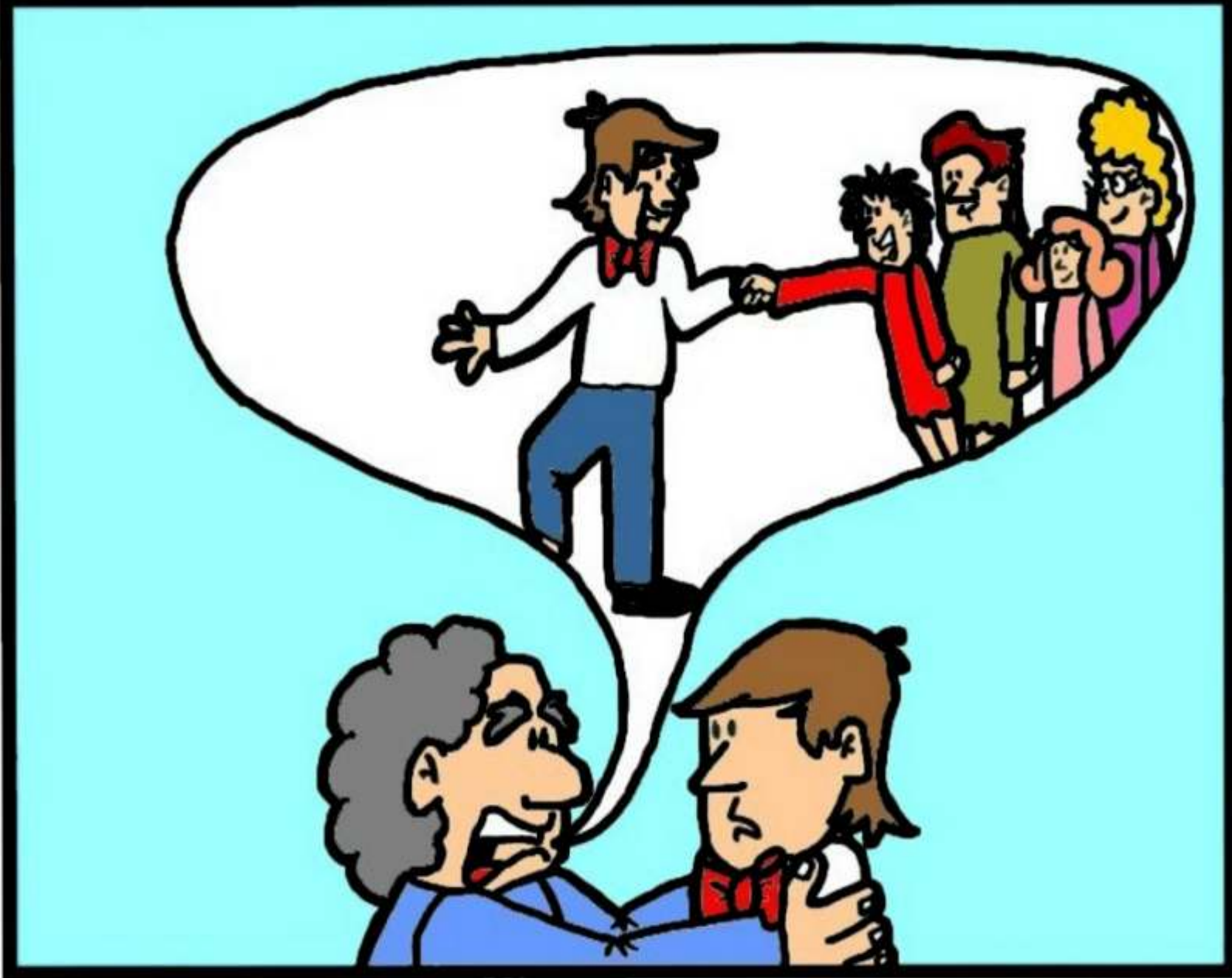
Another person said, 'I have brought five yoke of oxen and I have to go and try them out. Please have me excused.'
