
While Rebekah watered the camels, the servant stood, speechless and wondering.


Rebecca's brother Laban met them at the house. When he saw the gold nose ring and bracelets given to Rebecca he said, "Come In! Why are you standing outside?"




"Let me go back to my master Abraham," pleaded the servant. "We will call Rebecca and ask her," said the mother. "I want to go," answered Rebecca.
