"He's not here!" sobbed Mary. "We lost Jesus!" "Come, let's go back to Jerusalem and look for him," said Joseph.




For three days they had been looking for Jesus, when at last they looked at the temple. Someone at the temple was asking the bible smart guys hard questions and they were doing their best to answer.




Then the person who asked the questions gave the answers.


"That's Jesus talking!" gasped Mary. He's been here the whole time!"
