

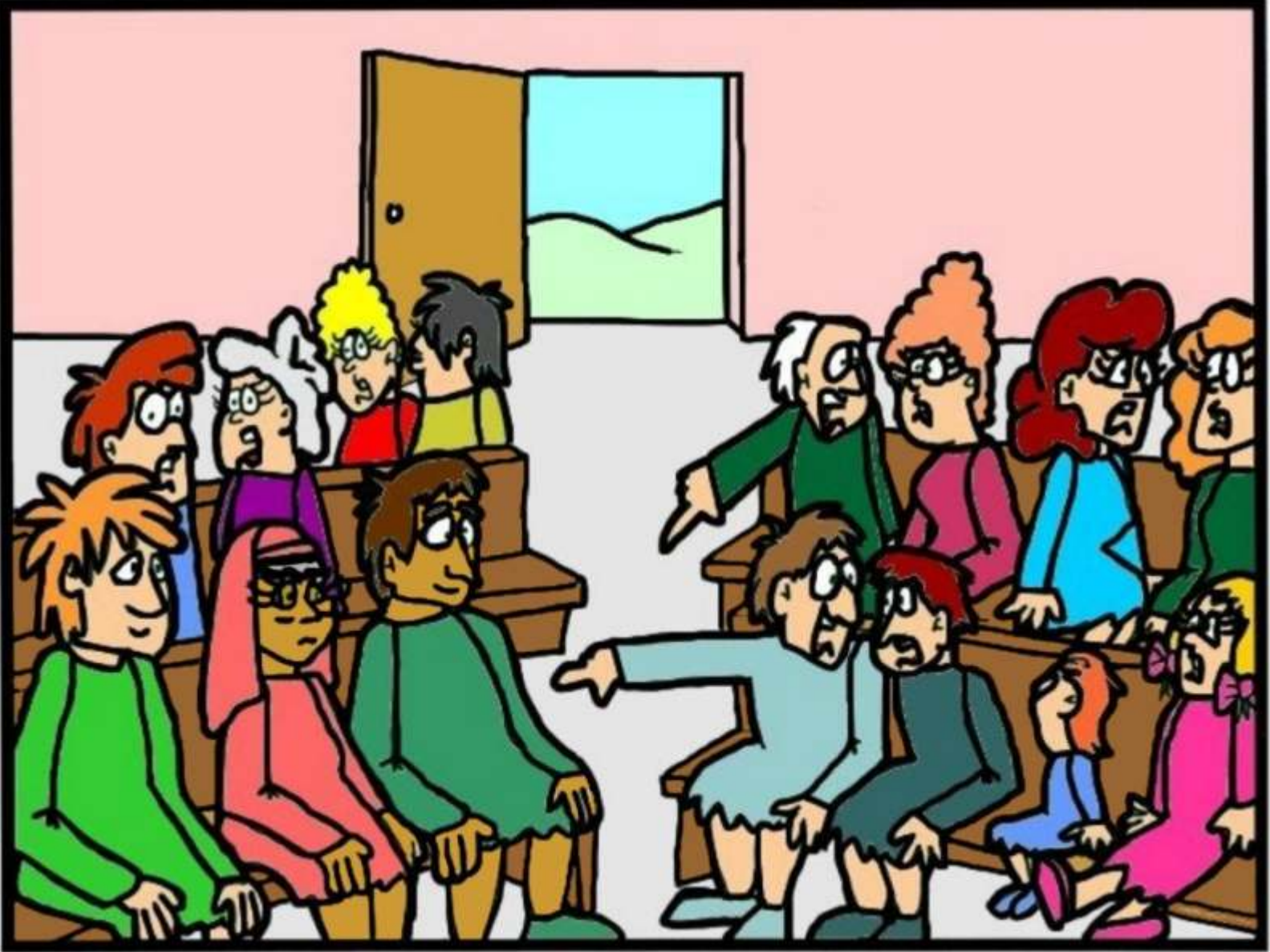
Last Visit to Nazareth
