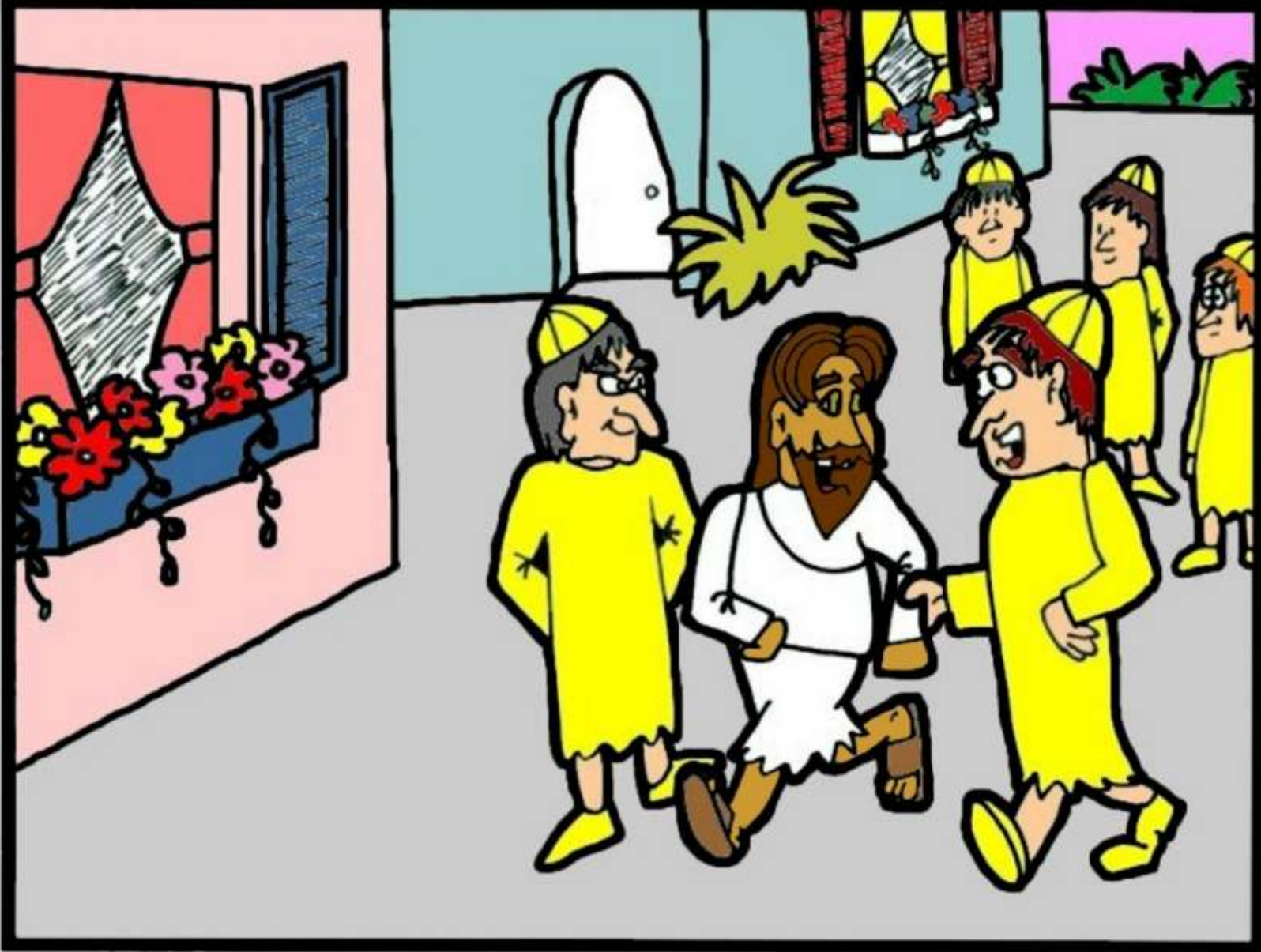


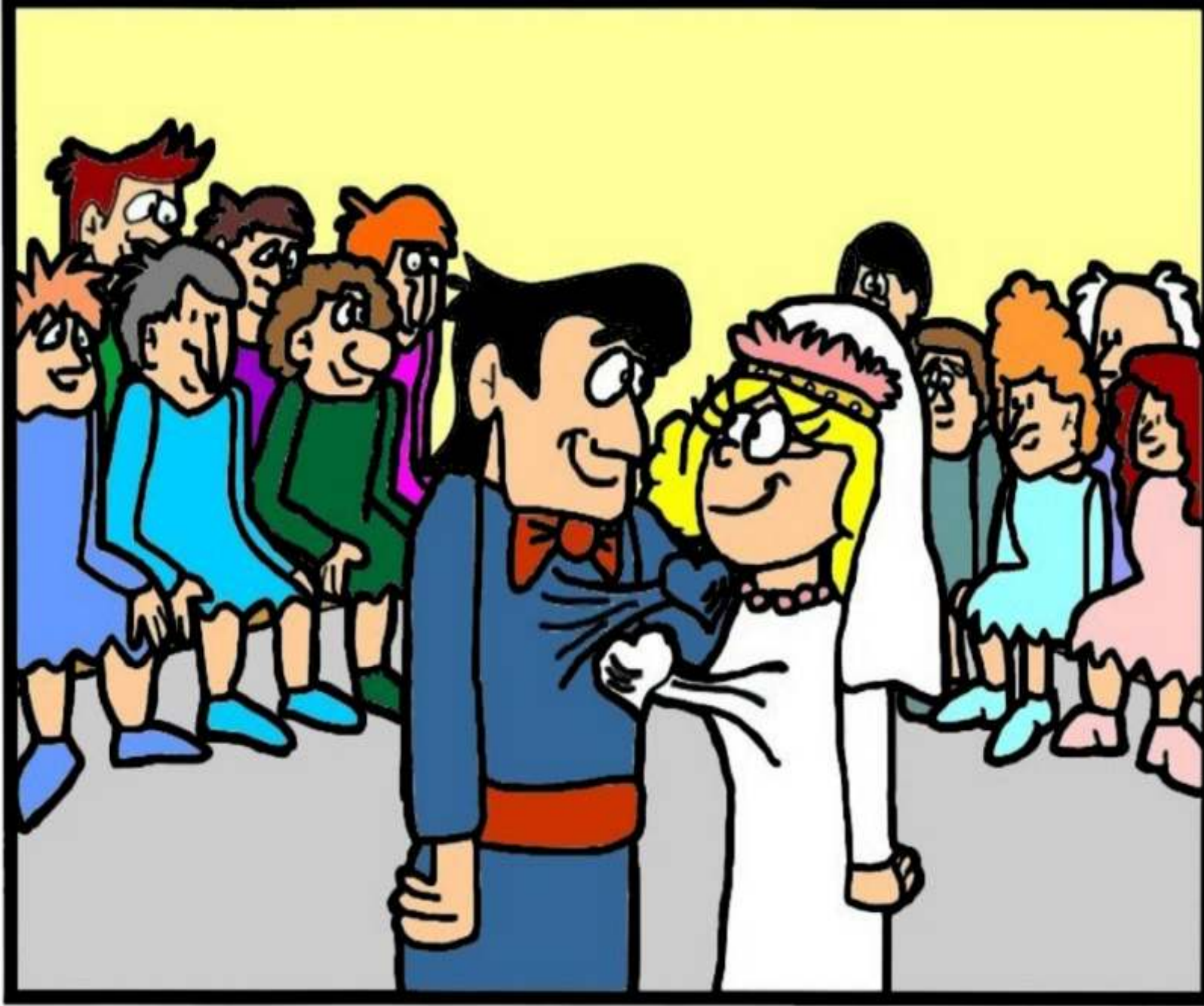
# Questions about Resurrection
