






"Jesus, we can't tell you," they answered. "Then I can't tell you either," answered Jesus. "But tell me what you think about this.







A man had two sons and he said to the first son, 'Go work in the vineyard today.' 'I will not,' answered the first son. But he changed his mind and went and worked after all.
