
## The Fall of Man


"You will not for sure die," answered the snake. "God knows that in the day you eat from it, your eyes will be opened, and you will be like gods, knowing good and evil."

"It's the cool part of the day! God is coming to see us!" said Adam. They hid in the trees from God. "Where are you Adam?" said God.






"Woman," said God. "In pain you will have children. You will want your husband and he will be the boss over you."
