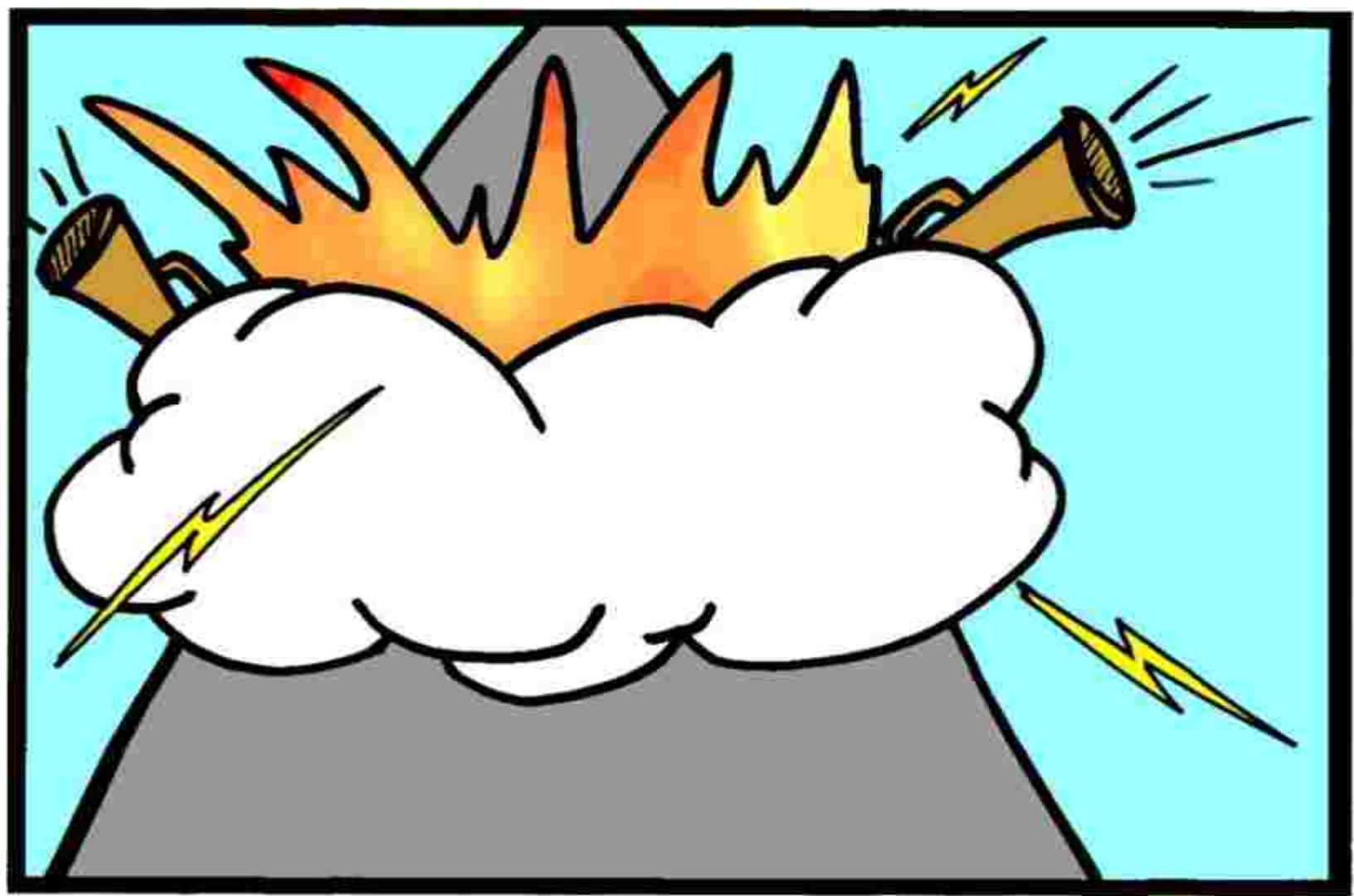

You shall not make for yourself any carved statue of anything and bow down to it for I am a jealous God.

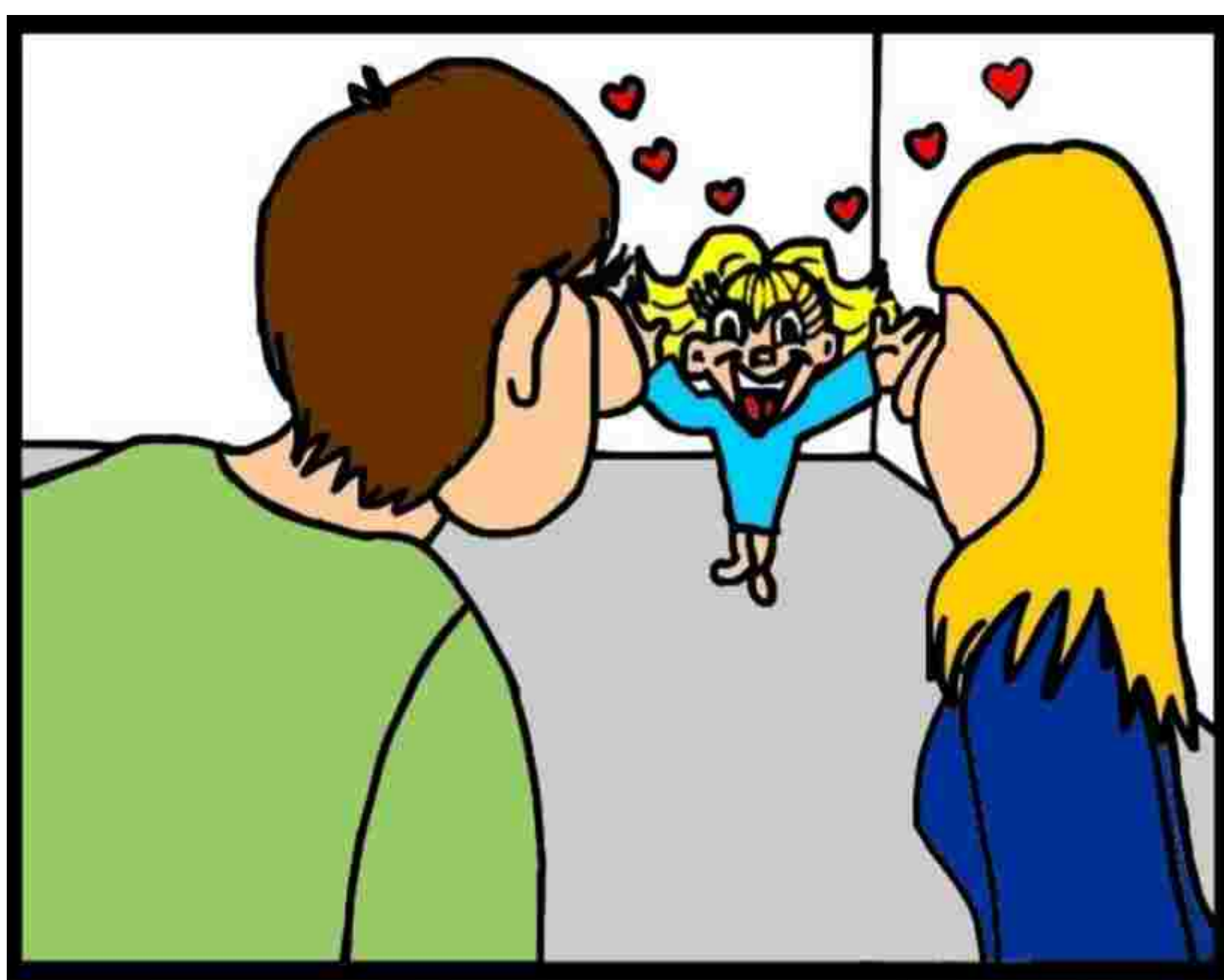


You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain because he will be guilty who takes my name in a worthless way.

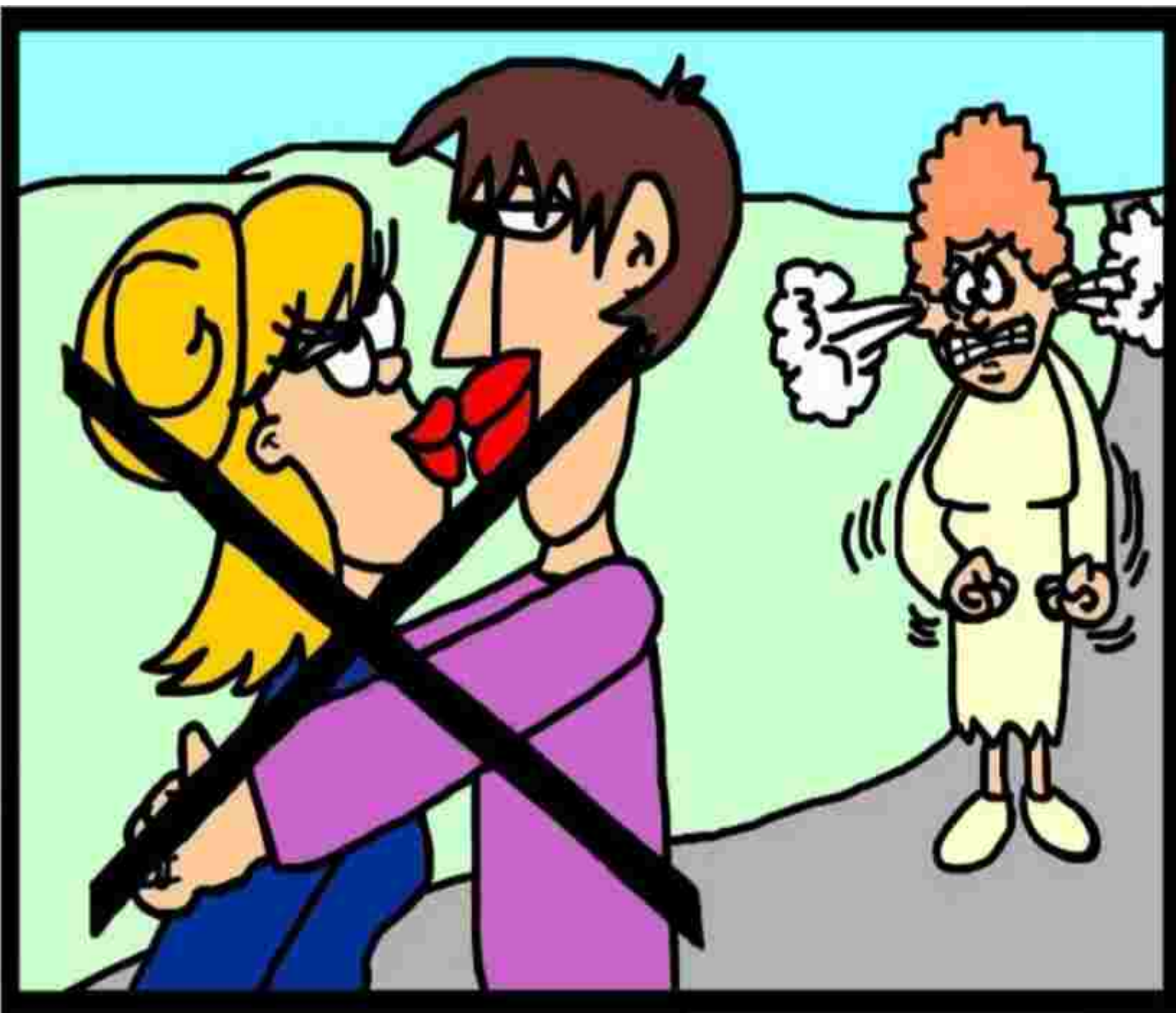

promised-land.



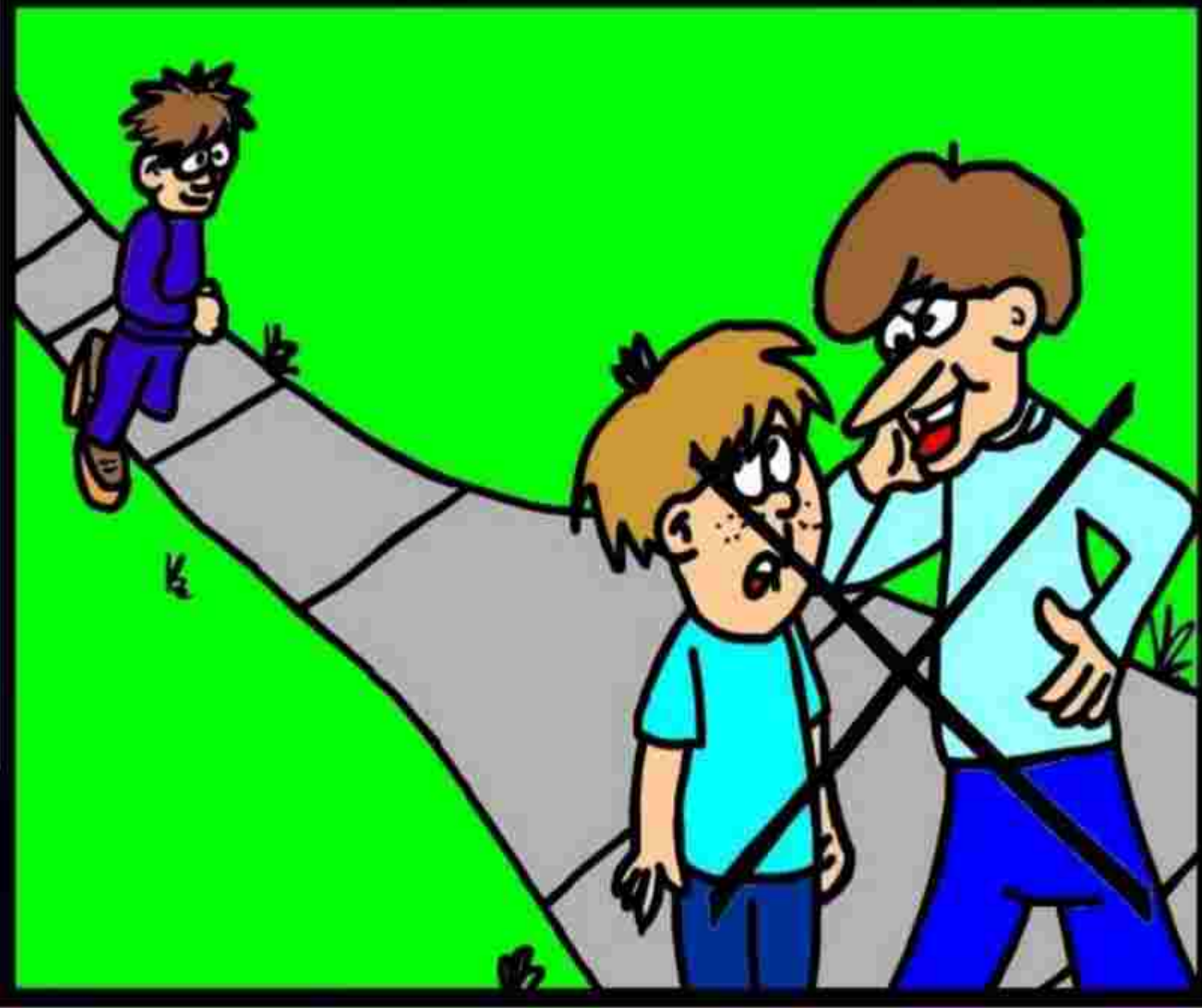
You shall not murder.



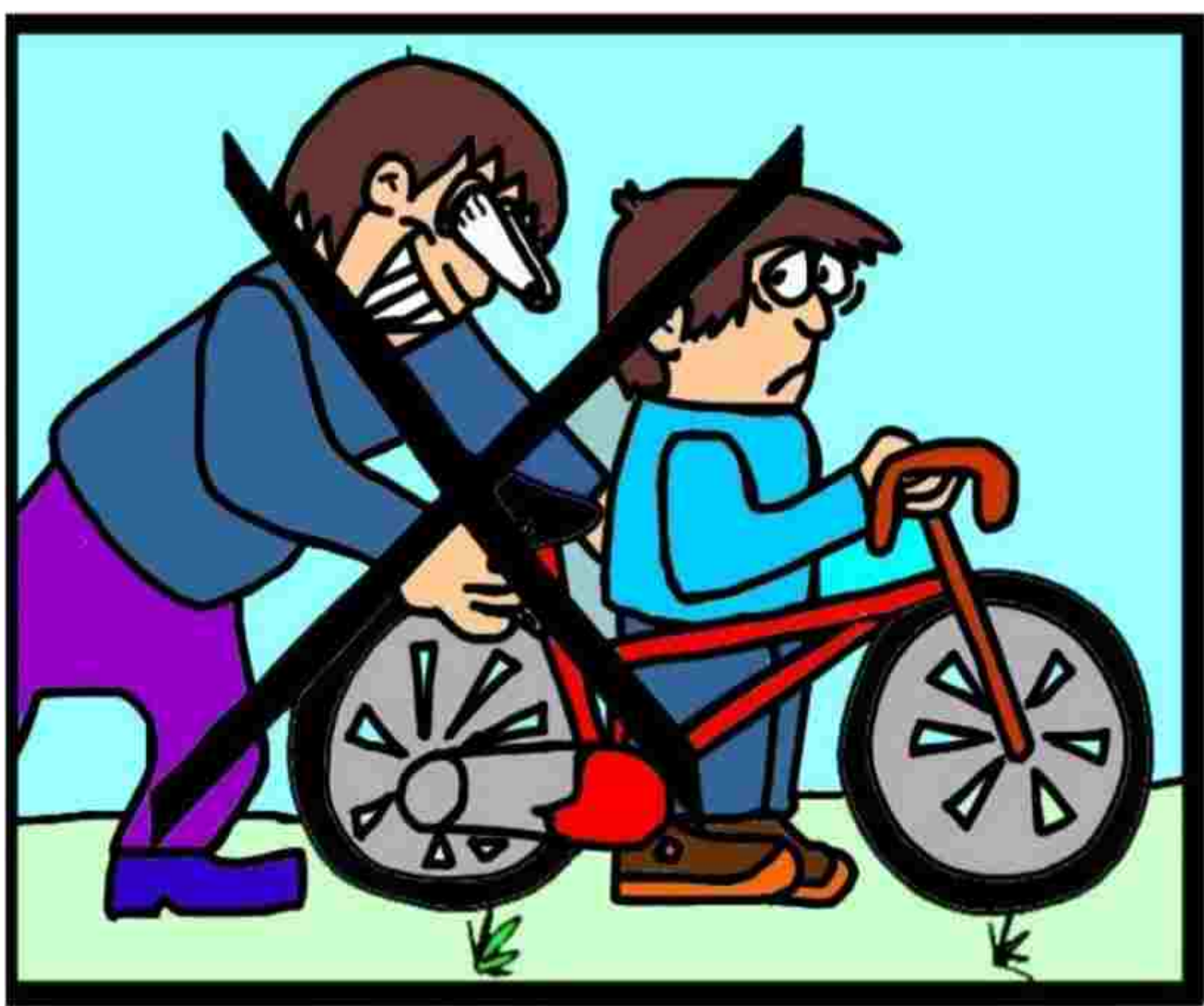
You shall not commit adultery.
