


After the flood that covered the whole earth, God commanded Noah and his sons to have lots of kids and fill the whole earth with people, and that's just what they began to do.




At that time everyone had one language and as the people traveled from the east it happened that they found a plain, a huge flat field, and they decided to stop and live there.



"Would you pass me a brick?" said one to another.


"Qu'est-ce que c'est?" answered his friend in a new language. So he passed him a hammer.
